

Dear Freedom Resident,

Now that spring is here it's time to plan on getting rid of all that junk that won't fit in your weekly trash bag.

This year we are planning a gradual spring curbside cleanup. We anticipate it will save the Town money and make your cleanup easier.

On April 22 begin putting your brown and white goods roadside. This stuff will be picked up on the regular Thursday, April 25 trash collection. This process will continue until May 6. Starting May 6, collection will be done every day through the final day Saturday May 11. Of course you will need to continue to put a trash sticker on your normal household trash bags.

Check the list we've enclosed with this letter to be sure of what we can take and not take. There is a charge for tires and propane tanks. Tires need to be off the rim. Air conditioners are not on the list but they need to be transported to the recycling center by the resident.

So begin putting your brown and white goods roadside on April 22 and make sure everything is out by 7:00 AM, Saturday, May 11.

Spring Cleanup Days: Brown and White Goods

Door to Door Pickup Thursdays beginning April 15 and ending May 11.

Acceptable items

Household items

- Mattresses and box springs;
- Furniture: sofas, chairs, and so forth;
- Washers, dryers, household appliances, dishwashers
- Metal chairs and tables
- Carpet: cut in 4 ft. sections and rolled
- File cabinets
- Water tanks
- Plastic pipe

Metal

- No larger than 2 people can handle; please pile metal separately

Tires (rimless only)

- 16 in. and under with a tire sticker available from the Town Office (\$2.00 each)

Unacceptable items

- Commercial construction debris
- Yard waste
- No Agricultural Plastics or Fabric Covering
- Household trash that is not in a garbage bags with a trash sticker
- Sheetrock
- Asphalt shingles
- Wood waste
- Demolition debris
- Gas cans or tanks
- Any container that contains a liquid, for example glue, tar, a solvent, resin, paint, caulking, gasoline, oil, and so forth

Items that can be taken to the Unity Area Recycling Center (the Town will not pick these items up). (207) 568-3117

- Televisions, computers, microwaves, monitors, and other electronics
- Fluorescent lamps, mercury vapor tubes, and CFL lamps
- Batteries
- Mercury thermostats and thermometers
