New Business

- Motion to accept contract with J Wilbur Construction, Corinth Maine, to raise Keen Hall and construct a new foundation for \$40,000
 - Time schedule: start July/August; Completion August/September ;approximately 30 days
 - \$13,500 deposit; \$13,000 during; \$13,500 upon completion
 - Myrick reviewed the contract with the members of FCCHS
 - Glenn Courtiere has also reviewed the contract; added an addendum with more specifics and signed it.
 - Warranty is 1 year
 - J Wilbur is fully insured
 - Motion to accept; seconded and voted unanimously to accept by FCCHS
 - Kate will cut a check and mail it out so that the work can begin as soon as possible
- Drew Fales is home and doing well SallyAnn reports. As a group we would like to do something to honor his work. FCCHS looking into American Chestnut Tree to be planted at Old Town Meeting House in his honor. Kate calling Fedco. Frances contacting Mofga.
- Myrick/Kate looking into ordering a plaques commemorating Drew's work.
- Grant proposals are still being generated based on Maine Philanthropy Center online recommendations. Perhaps we can look at the specific uses that Keen Hall will have for the community and target grants that are more specific
